# How do I Fill Out the Forms?

## Part 1: What Forms Do I Need?

If you want the court to clear an old conviction, you will need forms CR-180 and CR-181 to create a complete set.

CR-180 is the Petition for Dismissal, and CR-181 is the Order for Dismissal.

You will need to prepare a CR-180 and CR-181 for every case you want to expunge.

# How do I Fill Out the Forms?

There *may* be one additional form that you will need once you fill out your CR-180 and CR-181, but if you are working on this inside Kern County, these will probably be the only two forms you use.

Look at our presentation called “How Do I Serve And File My Paperwork?” to learn more about serving and filing these forms once they are filled in.

# How do I Fill Out the Forms?

## Part 2: What Information Do I Need?

You will need information about your case(s) to fill in the forms. You will need to know:

- 1) Your case number
  - 2) Whether your conviction was for a felony or misdemeanor
  - 3) What date you were convicted
  - 4) The code & section for the count(s) for which you were convicted
  - 5) Details about your sentence

You may also want to look up whether you can reduce your count(s) *and* have them dismissed. We will cover that a little bit later on in the presentation.

# How do I Fill Out the Forms?

## Part 2: What Information Do I Need?

You can get your case information in multiple ways. You can:

- 1) Request your RAP sheet from CA's Department of Justice (visit [kclawlib.org/exvideos](http://kclawlib.org/exvideos) for our video on how to do this)
  - 2) Visit the criminal clerks of Kern County Superior Court **WITH PHOTO ID** to request your case docket(s)
  - 3) Look up your information on [kern.courts.ca.gov](http://kern.courts.ca.gov)'s case information search

# How do I Fill Out the Forms?

## Part 2: What Information Do I Need?

In this presentation, we will show you how to create a free account and look up your case information on [kern.courts.ca.gov](https://kern.courts.ca.gov).

Creating the free account is like signing up for anything else online - you use an email and password to gain access to the case information search feature for Kern County Superior Court.

Note: This search will *not* show cases from other counties. If you want information about any county other than Kern, you can get a RAP sheet or contact the criminal

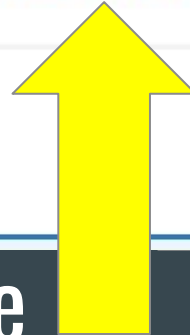

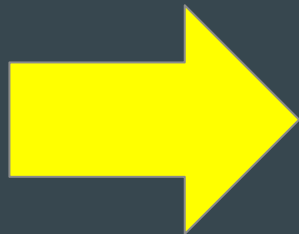

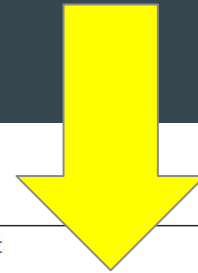

As of July 1, 2025, Local Rule 5.3.4 changed, and all *MISDEMEANOR* cases will initially be handled Ex Parte - in other words, if you only have misdemeanors in your case, you *may* not ever have to go to court.

**Only petitioners in felony matters will select and fill in a hearing date.**

# CR-180 Petition for Dismissal

## HOW TO SCHEDULE YOUR HEARING - FELONY CASES ONLY

- 1) You **must** select a date for your hearing that falls on a day of the week where the court hears motions. For example, if you are expunging a felony conviction at the Metro Justice Building in Bakersfield, their motion schedule runs Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, at 8:30 AM in Division **CC**. Other courts keep different schedules - see our web page for a list.
- 2) You **must** select a date that is at least 15 calendar days **after** you serve then file your documents (28 IN DELANO). Plan ahead - you need to pick a date where the District Attorney and Probation department get their copies of your documents, and you file your original documents with the appropriate criminal division with enough advanced notice.
- 3) You **must** select a date where you are certain you will be able to attend the hearing. If you schedule a hearing and do not attend, your petition will not be considered.

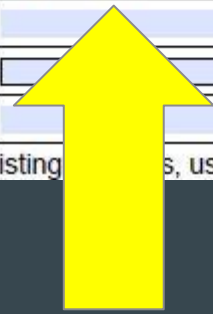

Hundreds of criminal offenses in California are “Wobblers” and “Wobblettes.” If you mark “Yes” under these boxes, and your offense is one that was eligible to be reduced to a lesser offense, the court *may* first reduce your type of offense, *and* grant the dismissal.

One option to check whether your offense is a Wobbler or Wobblette is to take the code section that you have filled in on the grid and Google whether it is a Wobbler/Wobblette, or not. You may find criminal defense attorneys have written about the crime you want removed from your record, and may even state explicitly whether your conviction was for a “wobbler”.

Example: “Is Penal Code section 273.5 a wobbler?”

You may also Google the code section and read the text of the law as it is posted on <https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/>, where it is displayed in its most current form.

Even if the court does not reduce your offense from a felony to a misdemeanor, or from a misdemeanor to an infraction, you still may have the conviction dismissed, anyway.

If you have more than one count you are trying to clear from your record, you can fill up to 5 lines on your CR-180, and use an MC-025 - Attachment to Judicial Council Form if you need to add more.

As long as the counts have the same case number and disposition date, you can put them on the same Petition. Remember, if all the counts are misdemeanors, you will file with the Misdemeanor department. If any count is a felony, you should file with the Felony department.
